The great composer Johannes Brahms at Lübeck's Academy of Music

The Academy of Music in Lübeck celebrates the 20th Brahms Festival under the motto "Brahms and the Music Culture of the Bourgeoisie".

Soloists from the Academy present chamber music, solo concerts and symphony concerts at the Concert Hall with varying thematic focuses around the great composer Johannes Brahms.

The founding of the Brahms Institute at the Academy of Music in 1992 offered a perfect reason to establish a festival which has, meanwhile, become an insider tip amongst classical music lovers. Brahms works are performed with ever-changing interpretations but as the theme of each year suggests, his contemporaries, predecessors and successors also find a place in the programme.

The festival is accompanied by exhibitions at the Brahms Institute which complement and broaden the musicological focus and present valuable artefacts from its extensive collection.

June 19th - September 5th 2011: Munch exhibition in Lübeck

Museum Behnhaus / Drägerhaus features Edvard Munch

A private Norwegian collection with more than 40 significant woodcuts of Edvard Munch will be on display this summer.

The exhibition shows prominent examples of Munch's entire productive period and woodcuts such as "Männerkopf in Frauenhaar" or "Abend Melancholie I" dating back to 1896 as well as "Kopf bei Kopf" from 1905 and "Mädchen auf der Brücke" from 1918.

New town map in Dutch language

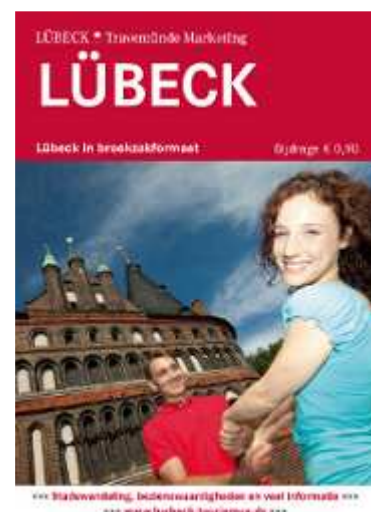
A growing number of visitors from the Netherlands enjoys the beauty of Lübeck and Travemünde and the neighbouring districts in Northern Germany.
